What happens next?

Your application will be taken to the next committee meeting. The committee meet every second Monday of each month. At the committee meeting it will be agreed if you are known by anyone, not known or your application refused.

What Happens next? (cont)

Following the committee meeting all names are placed on the notice board for a period of 7 days, as the law requires. If there are no objections to your application you then receive a call from the Membership Secretary inviting you to come and collect your membership card and club information.

This is an opportunity to ask questions and learn about all the facilities the club has to offer.

If you are unable to attend on the specific date to collect your membership card other arrangements will be made when it is convenient for yourself and the Subscription Secretary. It is important for you to attend.
